
Thank you for your letter of August 16, 2010 regarding the Fuller Road / Washington Avenue intersection project. This project appears on CDTC's 2010-15 Transportation Improvement Program (TIP) as project A461 (see [www.cdtcmo.org](http://www.cdtcmo.org).) It was added to CDTC's TIP several years ago because of expected benefits to delay, air quality and safety. The project has always been dependent upon significant non-federal funding.

The current concept and funding details listed in the TIP reflect discussions between the county (as project sponsor), the New York State Department of Transportation and the College of Nano Science that have CDTC's support. The eventual project design is dependent upon further engineering and environmental analysis and public participation carried out by the project sponsor.

Your thoughts and concerns on the project design should be shared directly with Albany County and its engineers to become part of the project record.
