Contrary to many of the public comments, Home Occupations have a long history of being regulated through Zoning. And there is ample case law as well as reference to any randomly selected New York State Town Code. (To randomly review a Town's Code you evidently need to first open a particular Town's Web site and go to it's Town Code link which will take you to the e-code site with the Town's Code. If you go directly to the e-code site it will try to get you to subscribe for a fee.)

The bad news is that that which is being proposed is very similar to the code for the Towns of Colonie and Bethlehem and I suspect many others.... The best to be hoped for is to find a model that would be least intrusive to McKownville and press for it.
